- 3. The "parol" can be of any shape and can use any material. The more creative and innovative, the better. It should be handmade and cost-efficient.
- 4. The size should be no less than TWO (2) feet in diameter and not greater than FIVE (5) feet across excluding the tassels.
- 5. It must be capable of being hung or may be propped on a pole that can be carried. It must comply all the safety regulations/requirements.

- 7. Submit a detailed soft copy of the design (COLOURED) that includes sizes, materials used and breakdown of all expenses in creating the "parol".
- 8. Attach also a coloured photo (all angles) of the finished product. Send it to ronaldo.villaver@gmail.com. Put in the SUBJECT: Lantern Making Contest 2022

- 9. After sending the soft copy of the design, the representative from Lantern Making Contest Committee will contact all participants.
- 10. All participants must bring their entries on 24 and 25 September 2022 at the festival venue.
- 11. Judging of all "parol" entries will be on 25 September 2022. Time to be advised.
- 12. All photos of the entries will be published in the event websites and in social media.
- 13. You acknowledge that the 2022 Philippine Christmas Festival Organising Committee and the 2022 Lantern Making Contest Committee are not responsible for, and accept no liability in relation to your participation to the Lantern Contest and the Philippine Christmas Festival 2022.
- 14. The decision of the judges shall be final and no correspondence or discussion shall be entered into.

Cost Efficiency 10%
